This standard was prepared by the Joint Standards Australia/Standards New Zealand Committee EL-002, *Safety of household and similar electrical appliances and small power transformers* to supersede AS/NZS 60335.2.74:2022 3 years from the date of publication of this standard. During this period, AS/NZS 60335.2.74:2022 and its amendments will remain current. Regulatory authorities that reference this standard in regulation may apply these requirements at a different time. This standard incorporates Amendment No. 1 (2024). The changes introduced by amendments are indicated in the text by a marginal bar and amendment number against the part affected. Where an application date other than immediate is applicable to an amendment, the date of application (DOA) and the date of withdrawal (DOW) if relevant, are indicated by the marginal bar against the part affected. Unless otherwise indicated, the application date of the changes introduced by Amendment No. 1 is gsgrtr 202x.

While this standard is an identical adoption of the third edition of IEC 60335-2-74, Household and similar electrical appliances – Safety – Part 2-74: Particular requirements for portable immersion heaters, including its amendment (2024), Part 1 of the series has been modified with national variations (AS/NZS 60335.1:2022).
